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Eva Mydlíková, PhD., MSc., Professor. A graduate psychologist with counseling psychological practice has begun to deal with unemployed, health and socially disadvantaged youth in Orava after the Velvet Revolution in postgraduate education. Between 2004 and 2009, she formed her further professional experience with qualification procedures in the field of social work. In 1991 she founded the first nonprofit sheltered workshop in Slovakia and received the scholarship of the most famous world foundations for the TYR Centrum project and since 1996 she is Ashoka fellows - a social innovator. From 1996 to 2004, she represented Slovakia in the European Commission- European Center for Work. Between 1991 and 2004, she conducted over 12 international projects based on applied research. After the revolution, she worked as a Slovak evaluator of projects by many foreign donors. After 15 years of psychological practice, she began teaching at the First Department of Social Work in Slovakia at the Faculty of Education of the Comenius University in Bratislava, where she worked until December 2015 as a assistant professor, associate professor, guarantor of the Bachelor's degree in Social Work 3.1.14, Head of Department, Director of the Institute of Social studies and Curative education, she worked as a vice-dean for the development of the faculty. Since December 2015, she works as an associate professor at the Faculty of Health Sciences and Social Work of the Trnava University of Trnava. She works at the Scientific Council at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Prešov, at the Scientific Council of the Institute of Social Work of the University of Hradec Králové. She led two scientific projects of the VEGA grant scheme, as a co-founder of VEGA in the University of Prešov and of the bilateral APVV grant from the PdF UK. She worked as a foreign expert in two international projects of University of Hradec Králové focused on family issues. Since its establishment in 2005 she has been a member of the Accreditation Commission of the Ministry of Labour, Social Affairs and Family of the Slovak Republic and also as a Vice-Chair of the Editorial Board of the International Journal- Czech and Slovak Social Work. Professional profiling goes to the field of work with family, counseling, and management in social work.
