Prospects of graduates	<p>The doctoral study programme prepares future graduates so that they are able to design and conduct innovative and high-quality research in the context of international research in the field of social work. In the third stage of study, attention is focused on a thorough orientation in past and current trends, philosophical concepts and theories of social work, along with their application to the chosen field of research, while the emphasis is also on the overlap of individual scientific disciplines and the resulting interdisciplinary aspect. The student acquires a broad professional knowledge in the field of study, which serves as a basis for conducting research and creating new knowledge in the field of social work.</p> <p>The graduate of the doctoral study program in the field of social work is characterized by critical, divergent and analytical thinking, which he applies during research work, pedagogical activity, but also in society as a whole. He can set research goals, formulate hypotheses and research questions, choose specific scientific methods of research, adequately and eruditely interpret the results, compare them with other researches and present scientific research activities with a clear argument before the scientific, professional and lay community in Slovakia and abroad. Conditions of admission	<p>A graduate of the second degree of university studies of the social work study program, as well as a graduate of related fields of study, can apply for admission to doctoral studies. Before the admission procedure for doctoral studies, the faculty will list the topics of dissertations. Applicants for doctoral studies apply for these topics. For each of the topics listed, a supervisor is appointed, who is an employee of the faculty for the established working hours and approved by the scientific council. If necessary, the student can also be assigned a trainer specialist, who must also be approved by the scientific council. The faculty, in agreement with the relevant guarantors of the department, can also accept the topic proposed by the applicant.</p>
Recruitment	<p>On the basis of documented documents and oral defence of their research intent, applicants will be ranked by the admissions committee and, according to the financial possibilities of the faculty, the first two will be selected for each form.</p>
Admission procedure	<p>The entrance exam consists of:</p> <p>a) Written exam of Language Competences (work with professional foreign language text) - constitutes 0-20% of the total evaluation; max. 60 points</p> <p>b) Written proposal of the research project (0-40%); max 40 points</p> <p>c) Oral presentation of the research intention (0-40%). Max 150 points</p> <p>Applicants for studies will be selected and accepted based on the results achieved.</p>
Admission conditions for foreign applicants	<p>Graduates of foreign universities with an adequate scope and content of study, who have nostrified diplomas, can also apply for admission. If the applicant has completed university studies abroad, the procedure is followed by Act No. 422/2015 Coll. on the recognition of documents on education and recognition of professional qualifications and on the amendment of certain acts and according to the procedures for the recognition of studies and documents of the Trnava University in Trnava. If such a student wants to study in the Slovak language, he must demonstrate his knowledge when defending his research intent.</p>
