

The dissertation exam topics

The dissertation exam consists of a written thesis for the dissertation exam and a debate on the written thesis based on the opinions of the supervisor, the opponent and the questions of the members of the examination board. The written work must contain of the theoretical and methodological bases of the dissertation project and the dissertation project itself.

The student also attaches a list of completed credits from the study department and a list of published articles and/or chapters, books, etc., registered in the library of Trnava University in Trnava.

The student will also answer a question asked by the members of the commission regarding following areas:

- 1. Theoretical and philosophical concepts in the context of the dissertation**
- 2. Reflection on methodological approaches in the context of the dissertation**
- 3. International or comparative perspective of the dissertation project**

After completing this subject, the student should be able to:

- to carry out an adequate analysis of the procedures applied to research in the relevant field of scientific knowledge,
- evaluate and create your own scientific text and research project with the inclusion of ethical standards,
- apply to her/his own research work theoretical knowledge in the field of philosophy of science and epistemology
- reflect on current theoretical discourse in social work and scientifically analyse specific theories within the topic of one's own dissertation,
- eruditely plan qualitative, quantitative, and mixed research with appropriate research design while adhering to ethical standards.
