Medical doctor, professionally focused on public health, public health care, quality of health and medical care, research on health systems, health and medical informatics and statistics, modelling, project management, health and hospital information systems. Pedagogically active at the Department of Public Health at the Faculty of Health Care and Social Work of the University of Trnava. Internationally active as an ECDC expert, visiting professor at Scranton University, USA and the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Novy Sad, Republic of Serbia. He teaches particular topics in the field of health policy, organization of health services, epidemiology of communicable and noncommunicable diseases, bio and health statistics. He published as an author or co-author of 130 scientific articles mostly in international journals, 30 of which were published in Current Contents and one published in the Nature Review of Neurology. He co-authored the manuscript of a scientific monograph on Health Statistics. The bio-statistics textbook where he co-authored was translated into Serbian and published in Serbia. He supervises PhD training for domestic and foreign students. Through EUROAID, MATRA (Netherlands), the EU 7th and 5th Framework Program (Jubilaum Fund, Austria), EUROAID projects, 2 US AID projects in Slovakia, projects supported by the Open Society Institute in the US, Albert Schweitzer Institute for Humanities, World Health Organization (WHO) consultations in Geneva, 12 years of cooperation with the International Institute of Applied System Analysis (IIASA) in Austria. Currently, he is responsible for the KEGA project on Propedeutics of Epidemiology and the FP7 project for CENTER-TBI. He is the holder of the gold medal of the Slovak Epidemiological and Vaccinological Society.
